## National Citizen Service Summer 2018

This week Scunthorpe United Trust visited Huntcliff School to offer your son/daughter an amazing opportunity on National Citizen Service (NCS) during summer 2018.

NCS has become the country's fastest growing youth movement with over 400,000 graduates to date. The once in a lifetime opportunity is a 4-week programme that helps young people build their confidence and gain new skills while having fun and giving back to their community – the best possible springboard for their future. Whether their sights are set on university, apprenticeships or getting straight into the working world, signing up to NCS is one of the best decisions a teenager can make. Scunthorpe United Trust are a local charity that have been running the programme for six years and delivered NCS to over 460 young people in 2017 across North Lincolnshire.

NCS is a government funded programme meaning that your son/daughter will receive £1500 worth of activities for a cost of no more than **£50**. Even better, if you return the completed application to school within a week of our assembly then your son/daughter will get a place for a discounted rate of only **£35\***.

\*Bursaries are also available on a case by case basis and support is provided for young people with additional needs.
